The event center is located at the Helsinki Olympic Stadium. Helsinki City Run's starts are from Mäntymäentie at 11.00 a.m. –11.40 a.m. Marathon starts at 2 p.m from Mäntymäentie. City 5 starts from Hammarskiöldintie street at 3 p.m- 3:10 p.m.
